- -The old hospital building and Dr. Click's office have officially been sold. Volunteers of America is pursuing a Brownsfield Grant for the removal and disposal of the asbestos in the building.
- -Cumberland Family Physicians (the clinic beside Walmart) are ahead of schedule.
- -Main Street has been bid again. The bids received were more than 6% over.
- -Gas Company is working on Logan Ave putting 4" pipe in, then going to Clover and Young Court.
- -Named to the 2AA Allstate Cross Country Team, Abby Bastin
- -Christmas Parade is Dec 2<sup>nd</sup>
- -Jingle Bell Jog is Dec 3rd
- -Memories on Main is available for purchase at the Library.
- -Veteran's Day Weekend, several events are planned, City Hall is closed on Friday.
- -To date we have collected 44% of our property taxes for the year.
- -ABC Regulatory Fees just came in at \$42,581.
