I. Call to Order, Welcome, Pledge and Prayer

Mayor Miller called to order the Special Called Meeting of the Stanford City Council at 6:30pm on Thursday, October 14th, 2021. All recited the pledge to the U.S. Flag after which prayer was led by Councilwoman Sara Givens.

II. Roll Call

A roll call was conducted with the following members present: Eddie Carter, Ronnie Deatherage, Sara Givens, Jason Hignite, Bill Miracle and Joe Tackett. A quorum was declared by the Mayor. Also present were: John Hackley, City Attorney and Fire Chief Scott Maples.

III. Approval of Minutes

Motion was made by Councilman Tackett (2nd by Councilman Hignite) to accept the minutes from the September 9th, 2021 Special Called City Council Meeting as written. All approved, motion carried.

IV. Citizen's Comments

Ellen Everett asked if the yards on 105 and 107 Sherwood will be finished. Mayor Miller stated that he will go down and take a look and speak with Travis at Greenscapes about adding more fill dirt. Concerning the mud and the new grass, that will be a project to complete in the Spring.

Kim Ruddy asked can something be done about addressing speeding on Logan Avenue. Mayor Miller shared that the mobile radar unit was just removed and tickets will begin being issued.

Pam Adams Lamb asked that speeders be addressed on Cash Creek and Hilltopper as well.

IV. Council Comments

Councilman Carter asked about an update on the Foster Lane Project, Mayor Miller stated it has all been approved and is in Frankfort's hands and has all been put out to bid.

Councilman Hignite congratulated Officer Nick Adams on his first shift working as a certified officer. Officer Adams just graduated from the DOCJT Police Academy in Richmond.

- V. **1st Reading of Ordinance 110.13 Annexing a 224.780 Acre Tract Being the Rowland Industrial Park**
Motion was made by Councilman Tackett (2nd by Councilman Carter) to have the 1st Reading of Ordinance 110.13 Annexing a 224.780 Acre Tract Being the Rowland Industrial Park. All in favor, motion carried. City Attorney John Hackley read a summary of the Ordinance that he had prepared.

VI. **Mayor's Information to Council**

Mayor Miller reported the following items to council:

- Habitat for Humanity is in the process of looking for a lot to build a home for a veteran here in Stanford. Several items have been donated to help complete this build.
 - ABC Report- 2 Quarters have almost paid for the truck. There are some reports still outstanding.
 - Bourbon Chase happens tomorrow night after the Car Show, all volunteers are welcome. There will also be a home football tomorrow night.
 - Pitman Creek Open House October 28, 2021.
 - Fire Department will soon go to 24 hour coverage to help with medical coverage. This was placed in the budget to try this for 6 months. Thank you to the fire department personnel for volunteering to help mow and cleanup while fall cleanup is happening.
 - Streetlight poles are decorated and look very nice! Thank you to all the downtown offices, businesses and churches that participated.
 - Fall Clean-up is currently underway and 2 dumpsters have already been filled with several more being placed to be filled this week.
 - Blacktopping has been laid on Arrowhead and Chickasaw, and Shawnee, River Drive and Ready Mix Street will be done once blacktop is available. Due to a joint venture with the County, Brock Drive will be blacktopped as well and that should start the following week.
 - Property Tax bills will be mailed tomorrow, the 15th.
 - Treat or Trick has been scheduled for 6-8pm on October 30, 2021.
- The Mayor encouraged everyone who has a complaint to please call City Hall so it can be documented and followed up on.

With no further business, a motion was made by Councilwoman Givens (2nd by Councilman Carter) to adjourn. All in favor, motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:02 pm.
