I. Call to Order, Welcome, Pledge and Prayer

Mayor Miller called to order the Regular Council Meeting of the Stanford City Council at 6:30pm on Thursday, November 9th, 2023. All recited the pledge to the U.S. Flag after which Councilman Ronnie Deatherage opened the meeting in prayer.

II. Roll Call

A roll call was conducted with the following members present: Eddie Carter, Ronnie Deatherage, Jason Hignite, Bill Miracle, Joe Tackett and Jerry Wilkinson. A quorum was declared by the Mayor.

III. Approval of Minutes

VI. Possible 1st Reading of Amendment to Planning & Zoning Ordinance 920.27

A recommendation was received from the Stanford Planning and Zoning Commission to update the Zoning Ordinance 920.27 for R-1, R-4, B-1, B-2, B-3, and I-1 zones.

A motion was made by Councilman Miracle (2nd by Councilman Deatherage) to have the 1st reading of Ordinance 920.27C. All in favor, motion carried. A summary of the Ordinance 920.27C was read by City Attorney John Hackley.

VII. Mayor's Information to Council

-The old hospital building and Dr. Click's office have officially been sold. Volunteers of America is pursuing a Brownsfield Grant for the removal and disposal of the asbestos in the building.

-Cumberland Family Physicians (the clinic beside Walmart) are ahead of schedule.

-Main Street has been bid again. The bids received were more than 6% over.

-Gas Company is working on Logan Ave putting 4" pipe in, then going to Clover and Young Court.

-Christmas Parade is Dec 2nd

-Jingle Bell Jog is Dec 3rd

-Memories on Main is available for purchase at the Library.


-Veteran's Day Weekend, several events are planned, City Hall is closed on Friday.
